This one week course enables students to gain confidence to work on their own projects at home or arrange to complete one of the many projects on offer here at the college.

Students can bring in their own tools or use the college's to learn how to grind and hone; create a flat base for a plane and maintain good edges on previously blunt and dull tools.

The course covers

- How to maintain and sharpen hand tools
- **Hand tool types, procedures and use.**
- How to mark out projects accurately and efficiently
- Plane setting, assembly, set up and correct use.
- **Sawing and chiselling**
- **Timber preparation**
- **Practical housing methods**
- **Basic joints including mortice and tenons.**

All practical exercises are dependent on the time taken to complete the foundations.
